Since 1991 tens of thousands of dollars in scholarships have been awarded to Benson High School graduates through the BHS Centennial of Education Scholarship Fund. Only the interest on this fund is awarded annually ensuring the continuation of this amazing scholarship program.

A \$2,500 contribution to the Centennial of Education Scholarship Fund makes it possible to give a "name specific" individual scholarship. Some scholarships are given in memory of loved ones; some are given in the name of a business, organization, or individual. Many classes hold scholarship fund drives as part of their reunion plans. Smaller donations are also welcome. These go into the "General Fund" from which numerous "General Fund and Alumni" scholarships are awarded annually based upon interest earnings.

SCHOLARSHIP CHALLENGES:

- With a \$2,500 donation (in honor of his mother): Warren Hanson, 1962 recipient of the Craig Johnson Award - issues a challenge to past Craig Johnson Award Recipients, their Families and all BRAVES FANS to send in their donations to the Benson High School Centennial of Education Scholarship Fund -Earmarked for Craig Johnson Memorial Scholarships.
- Graduates are challenged to make donations in the name of your graduation year. Once "class specific" donations reach \$2,500 an annual scholarship can be awarded in the name of your graduation year. (Example: The Class of 1954 currently awards a \$500 scholarship annually.)
