SUBJECT:	Nonpublic Student Aids Rates of Entitlement/Back to School Forms

In accordance with Minnesota state law, Benson Public Schools is required to ensure that all school-age children living within the district's boundaries are being educated. The district's primary role is to provide the necessary information and forms to each homeschool for compliance and documentation. The district has no educational records of students who have been homeschooled. Likewise, the district does not verify or certify any homeschool diploma or transcript.

HOMESCHOOL REGISTRATION

The following information is mandatory and must be submitted to the District Office by October 1 of each year. If complete information is not received, the district must report the homeschool as "not compliant" in its report to the state of Minnesota:

Existing Homeschool Students

Families must submit a **Letter of Intent to Continue to Provide Instruction** (enclosed) to the superintendent's office by October 1 of each year after a full initial report has been filed in the same district. Do NOT mail to the Minnesota Department of Education. Complete the information using the form enclosed or a format of your choice.

A **Student Report for Aids to Nonpublic Students** (enclosed) must be completed by the nonpublic school and filed with Benson School District by October 1 of each year. To be eligible for reimbursement, this form must be completed and submitted on time.

Nonpublic Pupil Aid Rates of Entitlement

Authorized rates of entitlement per eligible pupil for 2023-24 are listed below. Please note that these rates may be readjusted on or about October 15 when the actual appropriation and program participation figures are known.

- Textbooks/standardized tests/individualized instructional materials = \$95.69
- Pupil Health Services = \$85.30
- Secondary Pupil Guidance & Counseling Services = \$317.11

Special Education Services

Benson Public Schools is committed to locating any child residing within the school district's boundaries that has a disability and may be in need of special education services. Enclosed is a letter from our Director of Special Education with information about special education services.

Immunizations

All new homeschool students must submit a Pupil Immunization Form (which includes Conscientious Exemption, if applicable). Immunizations forms can be faxed to 320-843-2262 or mailed to the school with completed paperwork. This also applies to **returning students that reach the **age of 12** or enter **7th grade.** Fill out an **Immunization Form** (enclosed) if your child has new immunizations to report since last school year.

A Free and Reduced Lunch Application Form for 2023-2024 is enclosed. The Minnesota Department of Education requests a Compulsory Instruction Compliance Report and this information is included on the report. Please fill out the application and return with your homeschooling paperwork.
